This part-time position will be a jack-of-all trades, developing programming and assisting with community outreach, but will also provide outstanding service at the Children's Desk.

Job Description: Plan and present programs for children (from infants to teens) and their families at the library or at offsite locations.

Provide excellent customer service in the Children's Room and at partner sites, assist the children's librarian with projects related to the library's strategic plan and perform other tasks as required.

Must have a friendly and approachable style, and the ability to work with all age groups. Be able to create fun, dynamic programs and experiences that engage children and their families. Experience with children's literature is required. Proficiency with a range of technologies is essential.

Qualifications: Graduation from a regionally accredited or NYS registered college with an associate's degree or higher level in Nursery Education, Child Care, Early Childhood Development, or closely related field AND one year of full-time paid experience (or part-time equivalent) working with youth.

Job Type: Part-time. This position is for 30 hours per week. Schedule includes weekdays, evenings and Saturdays.
