Heidi will take the info she receives and work with the strategic planning committee to make the plan operational.
New Business	<ul> <li>Lisa Carr reported that Auburn Mayor will issue a proclamation regarding National Library Week at the City Council meeting scheduled for 4/27/23. Trustees should attend if possible.</li> <li>Lisa reported a phone caller asking about trans-gendered books and does the library supports other's beliefs? This raises security issues. She will be working with staff on this.</li> </ul>
Seymour Library Foundation	Clyde Howard reported he attended his first meeting as Trustee representative to the Foundation. The portfolio was reviewed, it grew 2.5%, for a balance of 4,000,000 plus. The portfolio needs to generate 125,000 a year to cover service on the roof loan. Current spending policy is to turn over on a rolling average 4% to the library, which was done until 2018 but not since. The next Foundation meeting will be held in late May/early June to review the financial audit.
