The meeting was called to order at 4:00 pm by Larry Liberatore, President.

The Agenda was approved on a motion by a motion by Clyde Howard, seconded by Lynda DeOrio, approved unanimously

Elaine began reviewing the audit by bringing up an issue which the Trustees will have to address. The Library receives a distribution from three charitable trusts and does not have access to the principal. The trusts are the Dorothy George Trust, Osbourne fund held by the Seymour Library Foundation, and the Dixon and Mary Blodgett Trust. In the past the Library has recognized the income received on the P&L. However, according to Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP), the value of the portion of the trust attributed to the Library (by the donor) should be recorded on the Balance Sheet, making is seem as if the Library has more assets than it really does. After discussion, the consensus was to go with GAAP rules rather than having a qualified opinion on the audit. Elaine suggested including a chart in the notes to detail information on the trusts. She continued to review the audit; there was a 500,000 decrease in assets, but a 900,000 improvement to the building (due to the Family Space and West Lobby projects).
