Resolution to Override Tax Cap for 2024 Fiscal year

Whereas, the adoption of the 2024 budget for Seymour Public Library District may require a tax levy increase that exceeds the tax cap imposed by state law as outlined in General Municipal Law Section 3-c adopted in 2011; and

Whereas, General Municipal Law Section 3-c expressly permits the library board to override the tax levy limit by a resolution approved by a vote of sixty percent of qualified board members; now therefore be it

Resolved, that the Board of Trustees of the Seymour Public Library District voted and approved to exceed the tax levy limit for 2024 by at least the sixty percent of the board of trustees as required by state law on June 27, 2023.
